Parish Lists

Rathfarnham Parish holds two lists of parishioners -

- 1. The General Parish Database with names, addresses and contact details of all parishioners. Currently c. 600 families are listed on this list. Back in 2018 we issued GDPR forms for you to fill in with this info.
- 2. The Register of Vestry Persons which parishioners sign up to if parishioners wish to have voting rights at our Annual Easter Vestry.

Currently c. 225 parishioners are on this register which is renewed annually in accordance with the Church of Ireland Constitution.

Signing up as a registered vestry person does NOT mean you will be put on the select vestry and become a trustee of the parish! There seems to be some confusion about this. The 12 members of the Select Vestry (aka trustees) are voted for at the Annual Easter Vestry by those who are on the Register of Vestry Persons.

This year's Annual Easter Vestry will be held immediately after the 10.30am service on Sunday 27th April. AG.

Good News Club together with Sunday Club and the Confirmation Candidates are supporting the **Pancakes** and **Prayer** Lent fund raising campaign to provide several schools in South Sudan within resources enabling every child to say: "I am educated, I am fed, I am safe and I am loved."



It costs a little over €10,000 per year to set up and maintain a school garden in a group of schools, feeding up to 3,500 children for a year at a cost of less than €3 per. That's not per child per day, but per year!

This is a project where a small amount of money can make a big difference - and where our prayers for safety, welfare and the protection and presence of our loving God can and will transform lives.


International and Interdenominational Service with the theme "I Made You Wonderful," written by the Women of the Cook Islands


Baptisms
